Wild West Yellowstone

This tour is also offered in reverse, from Cody, Wyoming to San Francisco, California.



On this tour you will experience singular and amazing natural wonders at Yellowstone N.P. An active volcanic caldera heats this bubbling, spitting, colorful hot spring landscape throughout the year.

Mammoth Hot Springs pictured left change in color and flow each year, building new terraces of white, yellow, orange, brown and black from carbonate rich waters. Wood walkways bring us within a finger's reach of the hot water.

Day 1: Meet in San Francisco, drive over Golden Gate Bridge, walk at viewpoint, dinner together nearby for introductions, receive documents.

Day 2: Drive along the Pacific Coast on Hwy 1, explore a marine preserve, then stop for food and fun at the lively Santa Cruz Boardwalk. Mission San Juan Bautista, night in Mariposa, best known for its local wineries.

Day 3: Exquisite visit to Yosemite, with its falls, ancient giant-tree forests, and blooming wildflower fields. Native American museum visit.

Day 4: Drive over scenic Tioga Pass, crossing the Sierra Nevadas to Mono Lake, where bizarre tufa rock forms line the shore. Night in Bridgeport.

Day 5: Visit to once thriving city, Bodie's Ghost Town. Drive along the Sierra Nevada, take a break in mineral hot springs, on to Bishop for lunch. Evening and night in Tonopah, with sunset hike in Monte Cristo's Badlands.

Day 6: In Tonopah, a partial ghost town that mined silver until the early 1900s. Optional turquoise mine tour. Drive America's loneliest road to Ely for the night.

Day 7: Drive on the "loneliest road in America" to unusual Great Basin National Park. Explore a cave and walk amongst over 4,000-year-old trees. 2 nights in Salt Lake City.

Day 8: Visit to the largest Mormon Temple Grounds in the world, and tour Utah's state capitol. Drive to scenic wildlife point on Antelope Island, a peninsula in the great Salt Lake. Swim, and look for a buffalo herd.

Day 9: Visit the 2002 Winter Olympics grounds. Drive to Fossil Butte National Monument, where a visitor center exhibits an unbelievable fossil record. Night in peaceful town Alpine by the Palisades Reservoir.

Day 10: Morning walk in Jackson, Wyoming. Optional white water rafting on Snake River. Afternoon boat ride and shoreline stroll at alpine Jenny Lake in Grand Teton National Park. Gorgeous drive through Yellowstone N.P., 3 nights in West Yellowstone.

Day 11: Visit world famous Mammoth Hot Springs. Drive over Dunraven Pass, where sightings of buffalo, elk, and other wildlife are common. Hope for a bear!

Day 12: Explore Yellowstone's highlights on foot: the "Grand Canyon of Yellowstone" and colorful, explosive Norris geyser basin.

Day 13: Highlight today is Midway Geyser Basin. Drive along lush shoreline of Yellowstone Lake to Cody. Visit Buffalo Bill Historical Centers. Goodbye dinner and night in Cody, Wyoming.

Day 14: Journey home or continue travel on your own.
