Itinerary Wild West Yellowstone (15 Days, 14 Nights)

May 3 – May 17, 2009

July 5 – July 19, 2009

(For the July tour we offer an optional 4 day extension to South Dakota, Mt. Rushmore.)

●	Day 1: Rendezvous evening in our Las Vegas hotel, Nevada. Introductions with dinner, distribution of travel itinerary for everyone.
●	Day 2: Start morning with a Tour of Hoover Dam, free time in the afternoon, late afternoon to evening spent experiencing highlights of Las Vegas. Night in Las Vegas.
●	Day 3: Travel down historic Highway 66 through gold mining town Jerome on our way to dinner in Sedona, Arizona. Continue into Oak Creek Canyon to Flagstaff for two nights.
●	Day 4: Experience Grand Canyon's South Rim by foot and by car. Return to Flagstaff via Williams.
●	Day 5: Drive to the Wupatki Ruins and Sunset Crater, which we'll explore on foot. 2 Nights in Page near Lake Powell.
●	Day 6: Native-American-guided tour through Antelope Canyon. Lunch at one of Lake Powell's beaches with optional boat ride. Evening special invitation at the Navajo Heritage Center.
●	Day 7: Hiking in the picturesque Canyonlands and Zion National Park. Night in log cabins in Panguitch, Utah.
●	Day 8: Today's highlight includes a trip to Bryce Canyon National Park, with a 3-hour hike down into the canyon (alternatives available). Visit to the extensive visitor center.
●	Day 9: First two stops in Cove Fort and the Bingham Copper Mine on our route to Salt Lake City. Evening on Antelope Island, and night in Salt Lake City.
●	Day 10: Short Mormon Temple tour in morning. Stop at the 2002 Winter Olympics town, on to Fossil Butte National Monument, continue on to true wild west town of Jackson Hole for the night.
●	Day 11: Begin with visit to National Museum of Wildlife Art. Then hiking along Jenny Lake in Grand Teton National Park. Afternoon drive to Yellowstone National Park with visit to Old Faithful geyser. 3 Nights in West Yellowstone, Montana.
●	Day 12: : Wildlife adventures – buffalos, elks, bears, moose and others. Start out visiting Mammoth Hot Springs with its unique travertine terraces. Then a walk near Tower Falls.
●	Day 13: Explore Yellowstone River's massive canyon, filled with colorful cliffs and thundering waterfalls. Walk through Norris Geyser Basin in the heart of Yellowstone, which offers multi-colored hot springs, pools, and many geysers.
●	Day 14: Drive into Cody, Wyoming, home of famous Buffalo Bill. Discover the many collections of Indian artifacts, wild western art, and natural history at Buffalo Bill Historical Museum. Night in Cody.
●	Day 15: Continue travels individually or journey home. 4-Day extended trip available in July as follows:
●	Day 15: Scenic drive through the Bighorn Mountains, with a stop in Burgess Junction, and a stroll to Shell Falls. Stop-over in Sheridan by Fort Phil Kearny, and a night in Gillette, Wyoming.
●	Day 16: Drive to unusual cliff called Devil's Tower, stop at Deadwood, Lead Gold Mine Museum. Overnight in Badlands National Park.
●	Day 17: Experience Badlands National Park with its exquisitely colored rock formations. See areas with fossil excavations. Short trail hikes and stop at visitor centers. Wounded Knee Museum, Custer State Park, Crazy Horse and Mount Rushmore monuments. Night in Rapid City.
●	Day 18: Continue touring individually or journey home!
